TRANSPORT	• Self-sponsored participants are encouraged to organize their own local transport from the airport and to and from the meeting venue daily. AUC-sponsored participants will be provided with airport transfers from the airport to the hotel upon arrival and from the hotel to the airport upon departure.
IMMIGRATION FORMALITIES	• All travelers to Harare must hold a valid national passport of at least 6 months before expiry with at least 2 consecutive empty visa pages. • To ensure a smooth entry process all participants are required to visit the e-visa website (https://www.evisa.gov.zw) .(https://www.evisa.gov.zw) • Participants are encouraged to apply for visas at the Embassy of Zimbabwe in their respective countries, where available. • In situations where the Zimbabwe embassy is not available, visa applications must be submitted electronically through the e-visa platform and queries should be submitted by email to

	evisazim@gmail.com evisazim@gmail.com The sponsors will reimburse sponsored participants for visa expenses upon submission of valid receipts. AUC Protocol, together with the Government of Zimbabwe, is preparing the Note Verbale to facilitate visa on arrival for participants.
TRAVEL & AIR TICKETS	For sponsored participants, and to avoid ineligible costs related to travel, you are encouraged to notify the organizers IMMEDIATELY in case of failure to travel due to unavoidable circumstances, to avoid late or non-cancellation of air tickets. Also, participants are advised to inform the secretariat 24 hours in advance if they are unable to travel.
MEDICAL AND HEALTH SERVICES	Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificates will be required from visitors who come from yellow fever regions or visitors who have passed through such regions. Participants in this category are required to be vaccinated at least ten days prior to entry into Zimbabwe. Participants without proof of vaccination will be immunized at the airport clinic at their own cost.
DSA	Daily subsistence allowance as per the sponsoring organization's regulations will be paid to AUC-sponsored participants. Participants are kindly advised to make sure that they keep their boarding passes, the receipts for visa fees and submit them to the organizers of the event.
WEATHER / CLIMATE	The current weather in Zimbabwe is warm to hot. The average low temperature for September only falls to 25°C (77°F). The average afternoon highs will be 27°C (80°F).
CURRENCY	USD is the local currency for Zimbabwe. Credit cards are accepted by most hotels.
